Moët & Chandon “Imperial” (France)		\$85.00
<i>Rich and creamy, this seems easy, yet has plenty of honey, candied fruit and apple notes filling out its medium-bodied frame. It is soft, with enough acidity to keep it focused.</i>		
Brut, Veuve Clicquot “Yellow Label” (France)		\$92.00
<i>Aromas of lemon, currant, clove and mint; slightly rustic. Then fresh and frothy, with a strong mousse. Distinctly floral suggestion of rose petal to go with the berry flavors, it boasts plenty of extract, and a generous, firm finish.</i>		
Ferrari Brut, Trentino Italy		\$54.00
<i>100% Chardonnay. Fresh and lasting, with significant overtones of ripe golden apples, wild flowers and a subtle and delicate fragrance of yeast. Clean and balanced, with a slight and pleasant finish of ripe fruit and a hint of bread crust.</i>		
Santa Margherita, Prosecco, Veneto, Italy		\$42.00
<i>100% Prosecco. This is a highly flavored dry and delicate sparkling wine. With peach and apple aromas, this fresh and balanced sparkling wine has fine perlage (bubbles) with a refreshing finish.</i>		
Roederer Estate Brut, California		\$48.00
<i>60% Chardonnay, 40% Pinot Noir. The Roederer Estate Brut is crisp and elegant with complex pear, spice and hazelnut flavors. It is fresh and lightly fruity with great finesse and depth of flavor.</i>		

White Wines

- White Zinfandel, Beringer, California** \$28
Fresh red berry, citrus and melon aromas and flavors, and round them out with subtle hints of nutmeg and clove. The wine has a youthful exuberance that is enjoyable as a sipper on its own, or with a variety of dishes.
- Chardonnay, Chateau St. Jean, Sonoma** \$38
Pleasant aromas of pear, mango and clove along with a hint of vanilla mingle on the nose of this classic Sonoma County Chardonnay. The well-balanced acidity wraps around a luscious core of pineapple, lemon and melon flavors and creates a creamy palate. The wine has a refreshing finish.
- Chardonnay, Ferrari-Carano, California** \$48
This wine features floral and fruit aromas of pear, Fuji apple, citrus and honey graham cracker with a hint of rich caramel and toasted coconut marshmallow. Generous on the palate, creamy vanilla undertones balance layers of toast and spice on the finish, while the tropical flavors linger to the end.
- Chardonnay, Rodney Strong Chalk Hill, Sonoma** \$36
Fermenting in new and seasoned French oak added toasty vanilla and spice complexities, and during 9 months of barrel aging, on the "lees" gives a certain fullness and creamy texture on the palate. Encouraging malolactic fermentation added additional character, and in the glass, the wine is both creamy and crisp, with abundant fruit character, mineral, and toasty oak flavors.
- Chardonnay, Kendall-Jackson Reserve, Santa Barbara** \$56
Tropical flavors such as mango and pineapple dance with aromas of peach, apple and pear. Richly layered and balanced throughout. Lightly buttered toast headlines the indulgent, lingering finish.
- Laboure-Roi Pouilly-Fuissé, France** \$45
Pale buttery gold in color. Floral and fruity, hints of honey and hazelnuts on the nose. Rich but dry, rounded white fruit flavors and ripe finish.
- Pinot Grigio, Bottega Vinaia, Trentino, Italy** \$38
This is a pale straw gold Pinot Grigio with a rare intensely alluring floral perfume. It is fresh, dry and flavorful with a firm structure leading into a lingering finish. It displays character and finesse.
- Pinot Grigio, Bertani, Veneto, Italy** \$36
A pale gold Pinot Grigio; complex bouquet with scents of golden apple, ripe pear and peach. Fruit aromas carry through on to the palate. Medium-bodied and dry, with a crisp, refreshing acidity.
- Pinot Grigio, Santa Margherita, Alto Adige, Italy** \$52
This dry white wine is pale straw-yellow in color. The clean, intense aroma and dry flavor with pleasant golden apple aftertaste makes this a wine of great character and versatility.
- Vermentino, La Cala, Sardinia, Italy** \$34
Few wines rival La Cala for its exceptional affinity with seafood, thanks to the very subtle presence of a natural marine salinity in the wine, credited to the Mediterranean location of Sella & Mosca's Vermentino vineyards. It is pale straw in color with hints of lemon-green. The bouquet is intense and delightfully floral and citrus. It is crisp and dry with youthful vitality and freshness.
- Vernaccia, Teruzzi & Puthod, Tuscany, Italy** \$36
This white wine of Tuscany is light green straw in color and possesses a bouquet that is fresh and fruity with notes of citrus. The palate is light and crisp with bright lemon-lime flavors. A slight flint accompanies notes of green apple. Harmonious, pleasantly complex in flavor with a soft mouthfeel. Delicious with all types of seafood, white meats and carpaccio.
- Gavi di Gavi, La Scolca, Piedmont, Italy** \$48
100% Cortese grapes, light straw color, typical Gavi nose; fine and pleasantly fresh. Delicate in the mouth, very dry, characterized by a crisp and refreshing acidity. Food Match: shellfish, quiche, fish, Antipasto.
- Sauvignon Blanc, Charles Krug, Napa Valley, California** \$35
This wine's inviting and complex bouquet blends notes of peach, green apple, melon, banana, guava and grapefruit. Its silky texture, crisp acidity and long finish make it a delicious wine.
- Sauvignon Blanc, Oyster Bay, Marlborough, New Zealand** \$32
It has that trademark "gooseberry" flavor of Sauvignon Blancs from Marlborough. Prominent grapefruit and green apricot flavors and acids which are crisp enough to make your mouth water.

Red Wines

Cabernet Sauvignon, Robert Mondavi, "Napa", California.....\$68

This Cabernet Sauvignon has deep, expressive aromas and flavors of berry and black currant with nuances of mocha, violets and spice. The fruit envelops an elegant structure with firm, velvety tannins and excellent length.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Chateau Ste. Michelle, Washington.....\$38

Highlights concentrated Washington red fruit in an accessible style. It offers expressive blackberry and black fruit characteristics and is a touch floral, with plenty of complexity and structure.

Joel Gott 815 Cabernet Sauvignon, California for\$45

The aromas burst with violet, vanilla, cedar, chocolate and cinnamon spice. Soft ripe tannins result in a balanced and long velvety finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve, Veramonte, Chile.....\$32

A blend of 90% Cabernet Sauvignon and 10% Merlot. Deep, dark ruby red, concentrated blackberry and black cherry aromas with well-integrated oak. Juicy red and black fruit highlighted with earthy notes and elegant oak that lend a creamy mouth feel. Plush with soft, rich tannins, this wine is concentrated, round and luxurious with a long finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Ferrari-Carano, Alexander Valley, California.....\$48

With aromas of blackberry syrup, boysenberry, spicy black currant, espresso and caramel, this wine delights with rich, delicious flavors of Bing cherry, chocolate, toffee and anise. A delicious mid-palate, excellent depth and showy tannins characterize this lively Cabernet Sauvignon.

Merlot, Simi Winery, Sonoma County, California.....\$56

Bright cherry, plum and blackberry aromas, accented with baking spices, cocoa and roses. Up front red berry fruit, medium-bodied with elegance and balance.

Merlot, Chateau Ste. Michelle, Washington.....\$38

The wine shows complex aromas of black cherries, red licorice and a touch of cedar. The mid-palate emphasizes sweet fruit, with a lingering cherry finish. It has the typical full structure of a Washington state Merlot.

Merlot, Casa Lapostolle, Cuvée Alexandre, Rapel Valley, Chile.....\$46

The nose features polished oak and bright berry aromas; the palate offers a perfect feel and impressive plum, berry, chocolate and vanilla flavors. Properly tannic and balanced.

Sangiovese, Rocca Della Macie Rubizzo, Tuscany, Italy.....\$34

Mainly Sangiovese with small percentage of Merlot. Very versatile wine it combines very well with many different courses. It is particularly suited to pair with pasta, soups, red or white meat, along with spicy foods. This wine is a brilliant ruby red with intense sensations of ripe red fruit. The palate is fresh and smooth, with a lingering finish.

Chianti Classico, Peppoli, Antinori, Tuscany, Italy.....\$48

90% Sangiovese, 10% Merlot and Syrah. Intense red fruit aromas, especially red currants and raspberries, are amplified by light hints of vanilla and coffee sensations. This full-bodied wine is pleasantly lingering with soft, sweet tannins. It should be drunk while still young for full expression of the fruit.

Chianti Classico, Santa Margherita, Tuscany, Italy.....\$54

Santa Margherita Chianti Classico offers an exemplary representation of the traditional, distinctive Sangiovese grape: elegant with tannic austerity and complex aromas. With a deep, ruby-red hue, this wine has rich nuances of wild berries, spices, and well-integrated oak.

Chateau Greysac, Medoc, France\$38

The characteristic style of Greysac is one of great aromatic finesse combined with good, full body. This complementarity produces wines with straightforward, clean flavors and sumptuous fruit which acquire elegance and complexity over time.

Red Wines

- Napa Cellars Pinot Noir, Napa Valley, California**\$48
This wine exudes characteristics of strawberry, cherry and sweet spice with a finish that is complex and persistent.
- Ca' Montebello Pinot Nero, Provincia Pavia, Italy**\$45
A Lively Rose that is intensely pink, with bright reflections. The Bouquet features fruit and floral hints. Fresh and smooth on the palate
- Ca' Montebello Sangue Di Giuda Dolce, Oltrepo Pavese, Italy**\$45
A Sweet wine of bright ruby red with purplish reflections. Full bodied and vinous with notes of violets, together with raspberry and blueberry jams, smooth and fragrant.
- Ca' Montebello Barbera, Oltrepo Pavese, Italy**\$45
This wine is a brilliant ruby red with violet reflections, intense, and harmonious with hints of prunes, leather and spices. On the plate full and well structured.
- Pinot Noir, La Crema Sonoma Coast, California**\$64
Aromas of ripe cherry, cocoa, anise and rich baking spices. Plush flavors of cherry, plum and pomegranate meld with hints of delicate tea leaf. Structured, balanced acidity and elegant, firm tannins round out the mouth.
- Pinot Noir, Buena Vista, Carneros, California**.....\$48
Aromas of bright Bing cherry, fresh ground nutmeg and earthy wild mushroom. The palate explores hints of toastiness and exhibits flavors of deep blackberry and cherry with undertones of dark chocolate and clove spice. This is a wine of depth that leads to a long finish complemented by soft tannins and lingering berry fruit.
- Malbec, Graffi gna Centenario, San Juan, Argentina**\$38
Deep red with purple nuances. A very complex bouquet, reminiscent of very ripe blackberries and the appearance of black pepper. Presents smooth, ripe and wellintegrated tannins, rounded and velvety. Its finish is complex, with notes of coffee, vanilla and toast.
- Châteauneuf-du-Pâpe, Lazaret, Burgundy, France**.....\$72
Has a full deep color with the bouquet of spice and old leather, with flavor and balance of tannin, length and ripe fruit.
- Shiraz, Jacob's Creek® Reserve, Barossa Valley, Australia**.....\$42
Light and appealing for a sense of delicacy to go along with the focused cherry and plum flavors, lingering against refined tannins.
- Poggio Molina Lo Scopaio Tuscany, Italy**.....\$48
Elegant purple, with aromas of red currant which immediately give way to flowers, tobacco and cinnamon. It has the mineral pureness of Cabernet Franc, the fragrance of Merlot and the vivacity of Sangiovese.
- Marques de Riscal Rioja Reserva, Spain**\$42
A dark cherry color with good depth. Balsamic aromas with hints of ripe fruit, complex and spicy. The attack is fresh and light, with soft, rounded tannins. The finish proves persistent with some reminders of toasted oak. Its passage through the mouth is pleasant and elegant, fresh and easy to drink.
- Villa Antinori, Tuscany, Italy**\$43
Intense ruby red color. Fruity hints on the nose blend well with the toasty, chocolate and vanilla notes from aging in wood. A complex, harmonious and wellstructured wine with smooth tannins and persistent fruity hints.
- Zinfandel, Joel Gott, California**.....\$45
Dry farmed, old head trained vines in Lodi and Amador produce intense, structured fruit while the Napa Valley harvest adds power, depth and complexity. Fruit from the cooler climate of Sonoma County offers classic Zinfandel aromatics of pepper and anise. Together, these diverse regions produce a Zinfandel packed with flavors of licorice, plums, Bing cherries and blackberries with a deep, long finish.

Vintage

Cabernet Sauvignon, Faust, Rutherford, Napa Valley \$82

79% Cabernet Sauvignon, 18% Merlot, 3% Cabernet Franc. Faust delivers a Cabernet with precision and style all of the aromatics, complexity and finesse that are the best of this vintage without giving up any power. A core of sweet, juicy black fruit, classic black cherry and blackberry flavors pick right up right on the palate where the aromas leave off. Faust is the epitomé of the style that has made Napa Cabernet Sauvignon world renowned: bold and powerful, yet elegant and concentrated.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Silver Oak, Alexander Valley \$145

Full-bodied, yet refined and consistent in its color, aromas, palate and finish. It has a dark garnet color and a nose of black cherry, clove, cinnamon, lavender and licorice. It is seamless on the palate with a solid core of berry fruit, velvety tannins and excellent length.

Fabiano Amarone Veneto, Italy \$88

Smooth texture, ripe, flavorful berry fruit: blueberry, blackberry, raspberry, sour cherry. Ample acidity, medium tannins, hints of earth. This is a very pleasing, soft-style amarone. It is big and bold, soft with a nice finish of fruit, acid and tannins in ample quantity and a hint of spice.

Chianti Classico, Ruffino Riserva Ducale Oro "Gold" Tuscany, Italy.....\$74

A minimum of 80% Sangiovese plus Cabernet and Merlot. Bouquet with notes of violets, cherries, plums and inviting spicy sensations. It is elegant and lush, inviting yet subtle. Full bodied, with a generous, fruity core, where the notes of cherries and small berry fruits intertwine with sensations of Mediterranean herbs, such as rosemary and thyme, and hints of oak. The alcohol is well-integrated in the structure and the tannins are impressive, yet round and soft. The aftertaste is very long and reminiscent of violets, nutmeg, plums and sweet tobacco.

Magnificat, Franciscan, Napa Valley, California.....\$78

73% Cabernet Sauvignon, 23% Merlot, 2% Malbec, 1% Petit Verdot, 1% Cabernet Franc. Elegant, well-structured mouthfeel, with cherries, rich chocolate, black pepper and vibrant plum flavors filling the palate. Very supple, with fine texture and firm structure, giving an immediately approachable richness. The finish is a seamless continuation of fruit and cocoa-like tannins.

Barolo, Ca Bianca, Piedmont, Italy\$90

100% Nebbiolo. Very bright garnet color; elegant and ethereal bouquet of vanilla, cloves, dried wild rose petals and clean woodland undergrowth; dry, full, firm but velvety flavor with a fine, very lingering aftertaste of licorice and oak. Tightly knit, solid wine with chewy tannins and raisiny, stemmy character. Full-bodied, long and muscular.

Brunello Barbi, Piedmont, Italy.....\$135

It is made with 100% Sangiovese grapes from Fattoria dei Barbi's best vineyards in Montalcino. The wine is aged for three years in oak barrels followed by a further 12 months in the bottle. Barbi is a delicate and silky red with a medium body, fine tannins and a plummy, fruity aftertaste with just a hint of vanilla.

Barbaresco Pio Cesare, Italy..... \$115

100% Nebbiolo grapes. This barbaresco has a glossy garnet color with light ruby shades. The bouquet is intense and fragrant with a hint of cinnamon and vanilla. This wine is quite full-bodied and powerful.

Brunello, Fanti, Italy\$135

The king of Italian wines. 100% Sangiovese Grosso, deep red color with a bouquet of wild fruits, very concentrated and spicy with accents of raspberries and an extremely smooth finish.

Quintessa, Rutherford, Napa Valley, California\$165

Sweet and inviting aromas of bright black fruit with red fruit undertones. It announces itself dramatically with a full lush entry, developing into a broad, rich and enrobing wine that coats the mouth with rich black fruit laced with a touch of mocha, licorice, sandalwood and vanilla spice. With tremendous density, concentration and ample fine tannins, this vintage is full and dramatic early and will age gracefully.

Vintage

Tignanello, Tuscany, Italy\$175

An incredible blend of 85% Sangiovese, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc featuring a very intense ruby red color. Nicely expressed varietal aromas with hints of black berry fruit. The palate is weighty, dense and vibrant with complex structure thanks to support of the acidity. Long and lingering with hints of chocolate, coffee and marmalade in the aftertaste. The beautifully handled tannin from the wine and wood blend making Tignanello a very complex, stylish and sophisticated wine.

Sassicaia, Tuscany, Italy\$295

Sassicaia is a blend of at least 85% Cabernet Sauvignon and up to 15% Cabernet Franc. Excellent color, soft in the mouth with great personality with a very soft and harmonious tannic content. The tannins' sweetness produced a very elegant wine, supported by a remarkable body. Very fruity and complex, deep flavors that linger, smooth and soft finish.

Tenuta dell' Ornellaia, Tuscany, Italy\$295

A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Cabernet Franc. An elegant, fresh wine with outstanding notes of dark fruit and vanilla. Here is a powerful, concentrated wine whose intensity is immediately obvious. Its complex, rich bouquet is complemented by sweet, dense-packed tannins and a lively acidity, and all of its components are in admirable harmony creating a very elegant wine.

Fumanelli, Amarone, Italy\$98

Our wine comes from grapes Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella and Molinara mixed to the other kind of grapes farmed in the estate, and the medium age of the vines is about 40 years. Intense garnet red with a typical nose of dried grapes, full bodied and warm on the pallet, soft and perfectly balanced with hints of vanilla, mature fruit and sweet nutmeg.

Opus One, Napa Valley, California 2007 vintage \$225 | 2005 vintage \$255

The shared dream of Baron Philippe De Rothschild and Robert Mondavi has produced some of the most acclaimed wines produced in Oakville California. Opus one hails from a 169 acre vineyard growing only traditional Bordeaux varietals of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec, and Petit Verdot. The wine features aromas of blueberry, rose petals, white truffle, licorice and nutmeg. A silky entry combines with a moderately soft mid-palate to express supple texture and a fine balance of fruit and acidity. Flavor of cassis black olives, raspberry and dark chocolate culminate in a long and luscious finish.

Dom Perignon, France\$260

There's a high-toned, minty, graphite accent to the aroma, with a citric edge on the palate. The structure is overlaid with lemon and bread dough notes, tight and crisp on the finish.

Perrier-Jouët® "Fleur de Champagne", France\$195

The wine shows hints of floral and fruit aromas, opening with white flowers and a touch of honey, ending with a hint of brioche. The palate is crisp and clean, with hints of almond and nougat. While the cuvée is light and elegant, it has a surprisingly long finish.

Perrier-Jouët® Fleur de Champagne Rosé, France\$385

This Champagne possesses both remarkable delicacy and finesse, as well as certain full-bodied mellowness - all bound together in a magically radiant hue, perfect for your special loved one. A hint of soft tannin from the additional Pinot Noir makes Fleur de Champagne Rosé an ideal partner for fine cuisine.
